AFFIDAVIT

The undersigned, of lawful age, being first duly sworn, upon oath deposes and as follows:

1. He is a Police Lieutenant currently assigned to the Detective Division with the City of Tulsa.
2. That the following offenses occurred in the City of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma.
3. He has read certain official investigative reports and statements of witnesses regarding the above-named Defendant(s) and, from these statements and reports it appears as follows:

On 06-02-2022 I met with complainant, MB at the Tulsa Police Department Detective Division. MB stated that she had been raped by an on-duty Tulsa Police Officer on Sunday, 04-17-2022. MB made the following statement:

MB stated that she was walking her dog back in the apartments near the area of 51st and Yale in the late afternoon hours. MB stated that a police car pulled alongside her, and she initially thought she was being stopped by the police. MB stated that the officer made small talk with her, asking her about her dog. She said the officer made a joke about the dog coming to work for the police department. MB said that the officer also made a comment about her appearance, then told her he shouldn't have said that since it's unprofessional. MB said that the officer got her phone number before he drove away.

MB stated that the officer called her several hours later. She said that she was walking back to her hotel room and observed a police car parked in the back portion of the hotel parking lot. MB stated that the officer drove up to her and approached her. She said that the officer was in a marked police car and was wearing a Tulsa Police uniform. MB said that the officer ended up in her hotel room. MB said that the officer asked her if she was a working girl (prostitute) and she replied that she was not. MB said that the officer sat on her bed and discussed how he had looked up her criminal record. She said that the officer told her that it wouldn't take much to put a person with her record back in prison. MB said that the officer patted the bed next to him, motioning her to come sit next to him. MB said that the officer kissed her neck and said something about how taboo and exciting it was for the two of them to do anything since he was a cop, and she was a criminal. MB said that she has a long criminal history but had never been framed for anything before. MB said that based on the officer's statement and the way he said it, she was terrified that he would plant something to fabricate an arrest.

MB said that when the officer told her how easy it would be to put a girl with her record back in jail, she knew what that meant. MB stated the officer put on a condom and had vaginal intercourse with her. She said that he flushed the condom after he was finished. MB stated that she didn't fight. MB said that the officer said something about being late for an end of shift meeting and left the hotel room. She said that the officer had introduced himself as 'Eric', and she saw the last name 'REYES' on his vest. She said that he was driving a marked Tulsa Police car at the time of the occurrence.

MB provided the number Reyes had called her from. I also have this phone number saved in my personal phone and know that it belongs to Tulsa Police Officer DeAngelo Reyes.

I accessed the database for Tulsa Police Body camera footage and searched for Officer Reyes's body camera footage from 04-17-2022. I located a video that started on 04-17-2022 at 15:44 hours. In the video it appears that Officer Reyes is driving through the apartments in the area of 51st and Yale. Reyes's body camera was on from his response to a previous call for service. In the body camera Reyes comes upon a woman that I identified in the video as MB. In the video Officer Reyes asks MB about her dog and makes a joke about the dog working for the police department. Officer Reyes asks MB asks about where she lives, what her name is, and says, "I'm Eric". In the video Reyes tells MB "You're sexy", "Is that unprofessional of me? I don't know, I'm sorry.", and "I'm just like, damn." In the video, Reyes asks MB if she's just chilling tonight and asks if he was wandering around where should he wander. Reyes asks MB if she has a room and then turns off his body camera. Reyes interacted with MB for approximately 60 seconds prior to turning off the body camera

I checked Officer Reyes's dispatch log and noted that he did not respond to any calls for service during the final 2 hours of his patrol shift. For the vast majority of that time, I noted that he had checked out with dispatch as

being busy writing police reports. I also noticed in the dispatch logs that Reyes did not generate any police reports during his shift on 04-17-2022.

A check of the Tulsa Regional Area Criminal Information System (TRACIS) shows that Reyes searched police records for information associated with MB in the time frame of their initial encounter.


A search warrant was written to collect Reyes's cellular phone in relation to this investigation. Internal Affairs and department command staff were also informed of the nature of the investigation. It was determined that the search warrant would be served and Reyes would be placed on Administrative Leave on his next shift which was scheduled for 06-05-2022.

SVU detectives and IA personnel met Reyes at the Riverside Division upon his arrival for his scheduled shift on 06-05-2022. Reyes cell phone was collected, and he provided an initial statement to SVU detectives. During his initial statement Reyes stated that he recalled encountering MB. Reyes stated that he believed she may be a person of interest that had information on a homicide, so he approached her. He described her as becoming agitated, so he got her phone number to follow up later. Reyes stated that he did call her and follow up later with her at her hotel room but denied any sexual contact. Reyes was asked if he has ever introduced himself as 'Eric' or would have any reason to. Reyes denied introducing himself as 'Eric'.

Reyes and an attorney scheduled a follow-up interview on 06-08-2022. Reyes stated that he lied during his initial statement. Reyes said that he thought it was about him doing something on duty he shouldn't be doing, and he wasn't ready to be truthful about it. Reyes stated that he did introduce himself as Eric and approached MB with the intention of initiating a no-strings-attached encounter. Reyes stated that he did call MB and met her at a nearby motel while he was still on duty. Reyes stated that he dishonestly checked out with dispatch on reports. Reyes stated that MB initiated the sexual contact, they had sex, and he perceived the encounter as consensual.




